work as a self contained bubble in our classrooms.

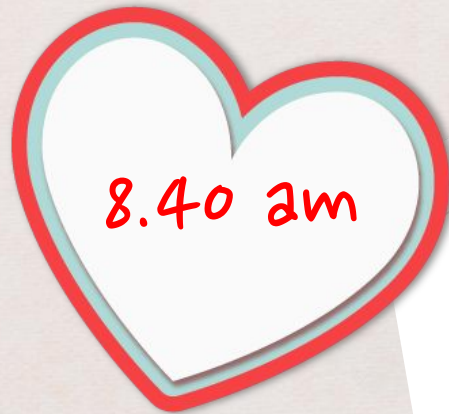
This will allow us to access the provision indoors

## washing and cleaning!



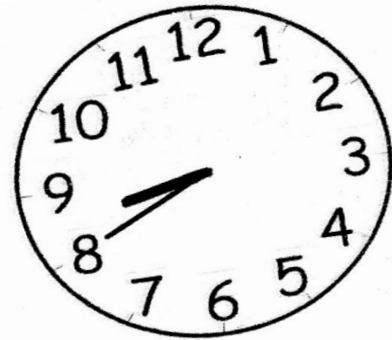

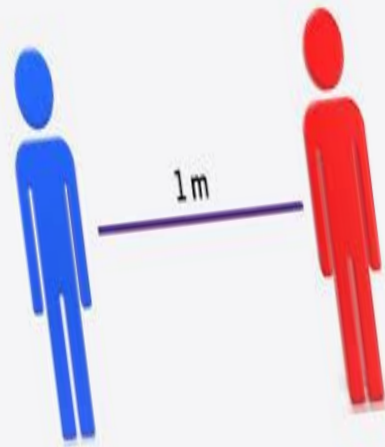


## Morning Start Time

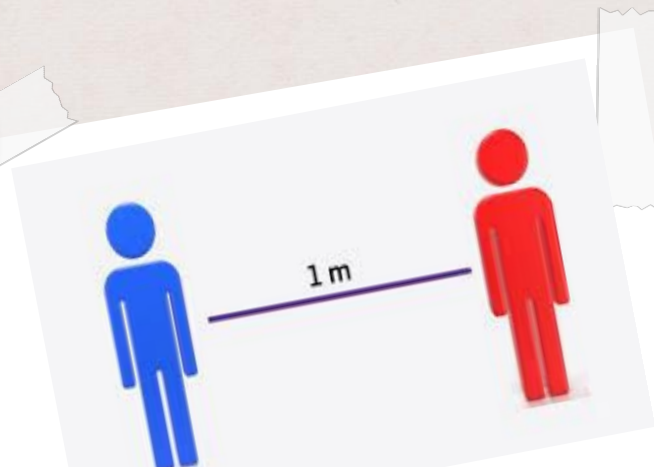
