This will allow us to access the provision indoors and outdoors.




washing and cleaning!

The shared toys and resources will be cleaned daily and the children and staff will be washing their hands regularly throughout the day. We will also have some adaptations to our provision, such as disposable painting aprons for example.

During the first half term the kitchen will be closed so it will be prepared off site and delivered. It will be a limited menu. You may also send a packed lunch. Going home at the end of the day


