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We will send out a letter with your new peg picture on. This will be in your starting nursery pack. This is what it will look like...







We've set up the areas in Nursery so not too many children play in them at the same time. This is how you will know how many children can play in the space. But don't worry we will help you learn this too.





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We may be taking it in turns to do things like playing outside in small groups, or as part of the whole class.



In our garden you can explore, investigate, imagine and create.



You will also need to go to the toilet while you are in Nursery. It's also important that we keep our hands really clean to stop us passing on germs. This is where you can do this after the toilet and at other times in the day.





We've got lots of tissues for you to use for blowing your nose. We've put them right next to the bin so you can pop it straight in afterwards.





Don't forget to wash your hands again!

When you are in Nursery you will have milk and snack in the morning. We have our snack at the tables and you can help prepare it. We also learn to use our knife and fork and to set the table for lunch.



Some of you may be staying all day. Your grown up will tell you if you are. You will have your milk and snack in the morning and you will also have your dinner in Nursery too!



Your grown-ups can make you a packed lunch to bring to Nursery or they can order you a lunch. We'll explain to them how to do that later.

When it's time for you to go home, this is where we will take you to meet your grown-up. You can tell them all about your day.


