<u>Meet The Teacher Year 2 2020</u>

The Year 2 teachers are Mr Waters and Miss Watson in Hazel Class and Mrs Hedley in Cherry Class. Our support staff are Mrs Carter and Mrs Humphreys. Mrs Hinson, Mrs Wilson or Mrs McConnell cover Year 2 when we are planning.

We want the children to be happy, safe and confident.

We have high expectations of behaviour and progress. We encourage the children to do their best through:

House points

As you are aware, your child is in a "house." (Humford, Bolam, Plessey, Simonside, Kielder.) They earn "house points" for their house for excellent work, effort, behaviour, manners etc. The house points are counted up each week and announced in assembly. The winning house each half term is awarded a house treat although the treat may look different this year given the circumstances.

<u>Golden Book</u>

Each week we have a golden assembly on Friday morning and we are currently doing this virtually. The teachers put the names of two children who have excelled in the golden book. They can stand up if they wish to and receive a sticker and a small prize. Teachers keep a record of who has been in the book and all children will be entered during the year.

Traffic lights

We have a traffic light system in each classroom. The children's names are placed on the green light and we expect them to stay there. If a child behaves inappropriately, their name is moved to the amber light which is a warning. If inappropriate behaviour continues, the name will be moved to red and the child will miss some playtime. Children will start each new session of the day on green.

Marble Jar Of Good Choices

The children earn a marble for our class jar for good choices, following the rules and working hard. We listen to the sound of our success as it drops. We get a treat when the jar is full.

PHSEe lessons/ Circle time

We have planned Personal, Health, Social, Emotional and Economic lessons each week where we give the children the opportunity to discuss their views, concerns, feelings and experiences openly.
