
HELLO PARENTS!

WORKING TOGETHER TO SUPPORT YOUR CHILD'S LEARNING


Children learn best when there is a good learning partnership between home and school.

Here are some you may meet.

Mrs Bushell

Mrs Bushell, is our Headteacher. Her role is keeping the school running the smoothly.
