As a part of your child's educational experience at West End Primary School, we aim to promote personal wellbeing and development through a comprehensive taught programme of Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) education that gives children the knowledge, understanding, attitudes and practical skills to live healthy, safe, productive and fulfilled lives, both now and in the future.

As you may already be aware, Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) is to become statutory in all primary schools from September 2021 following a nationwide consultation. We are pleased that this decision has been made as it means that all children will be taught about a wide range of topics relating to physical and mental health, wellbeing, safeguarding and healthy relationships. In providing children with an understanding of healthy and respectful relationships and appropriate boundaries, we consider effective RSE to be a fundamental part of our approach to supporting pupils to grow into confident, caring, responsible and respectful young citizens who understand how to cope with life and live safely and happily in the modern world. . Consequently, from September 2021, Relationships and Sex Education (RSE), along with Health Education, will be statutory and form part of the National Curriculum.

This means we have been reviewing our PSHE and RSE curriculum and policy so that we can be sure our PSHE and RSE provision is appropriate for our pupils based on their:

- Age
- Physical and emotional maturity
- Religious and cultural backgrounds
- Special educational needs and disabilities
