Autumn and Winter Illnesses

There are a lot of nasty bugs and colds going around at the moment. Please help us to minimise the risk of spreading illnesses around by keeping your child at home if he/she has the following:

- If your child has sickness and diarrhoea he/she must stay off school until 48 hours after the last bout of diarrhoea or vomiting
- If your child has a heavy cold he/she should stay off school until well enough to return, i.e. when the worst of the cold symptoms are finished and your child is less likely to pass on infections by frequent coughing or sneezing
- If you suspect your child has Covid and have a test kit you should test your child and if the test is positive he/she should stay off school for 3 full days, only returning if he/she no longer has a temperature. If your child does not have Covid or if you are unable to test, he/she should stay off school until well enough to return. Please keep your child off school until any temperature has gone.



Flu Immunisations

The flu immunisations will be given in school on **Tuesday 8 November**. Children will only be immunised if parents have completed the on-form which was sent out at the beginning of September. There is still time to complete this if you wish your child to receive the immunisation.
