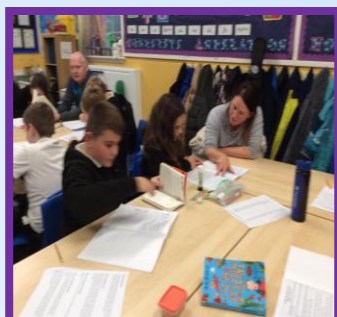

 The children loved WWII day and have completed some amazing reading week activities.



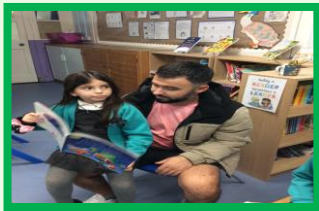
Year 4

fortnight of non-stop activities and fun!





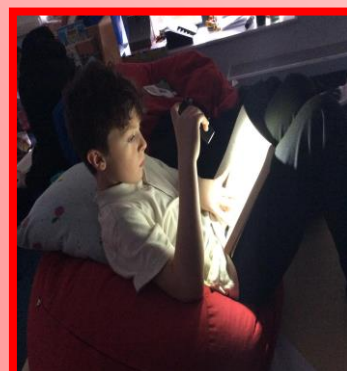
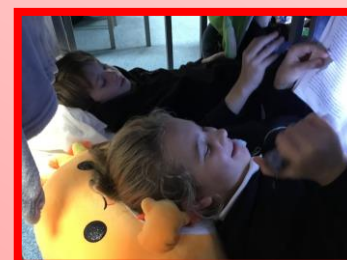
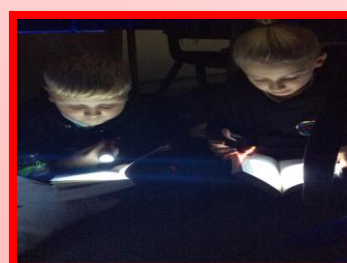
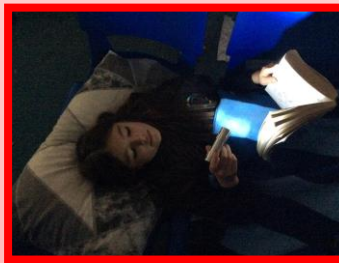
Year 3
