#### Reception Places 2019

The online portal for applications for Reception class places for September 2019 opened on 1<sup>st</sup> November 2018. The portal is available on the Northumberland County Council website at <a href="https://www.northumberland.gov.uk/Education/Schools/Admissions.aspx">www.northumberland.gov.uk/Education/Schools/Admissions.aspx</a>.



Applications for a Reception place must be made via the portal, even if your child is already attending West End First School nursery or West End Pre-school. The portal closes on 15<sup>th</sup> January 2019. It is essential that applications are made before the deadline if you wish to be considered for a place at your first choice school.
