Week 1	Words ending in -ious and -tious	Infectious, notorious, devious, ambitious, repetitious, curious,, nutritious, amphibious, fictitious, obvious
Week 2	Words ending in -cious	delicious, atrocious, ferocious, gracious, malicious, luscious, precious conscious, spacious, suspicious
Week 3	Words ending in -cial	special, official, artificial crucial, judicial, beneficial Facial, glacial, especially, multiracial
Week 4	Words ending in -tial	circumstantial, torrential, confidential, essential, impartial, substantial, preferential, potential, influential, residential
Week 5	Words ending in -cial, -tial, -cial	financial, commercial, provincial, initial, palacial, spatial, controversial, initially financially, controversially
Week 6	Challenge words	appreciate, cemetery, conscious, convenience, environment, immediately , language, sufficient, thorough, vegetable
Week 7	Words ending in -ant	distant, elegant, mabundant, fragrant, brilliant, ignorant, constant, tolerant, dominant, vacant
