The purpose of this activity is to help the children to understand that they are able to make a difference to a person by saying something thoughtful and that by creating such a positive environment they are being proactive in the prevention of unkindness and bullying. Ask your child what compliments he/she received and how it made him/her feel.

Staff Car Park

Unfortunately, due to very limited space, the staff car park is for the use of school staff only.
