

Dear Parents,

We have been discussing our rules, rewards and consequences and would like to share these with you so you can also talk to the children about them.

Beech and Willow Rules are the same as those for the whole school:-

In Class:

1. We are gentle.
2. We are kind and helpful.
3. We listen.
4. We are honest.
5. We look after our property.
6. We work hard.

On the Playground;

1. We are gentle.
2. We are kind and helpful.
3. We listen.
4. We are honest.
5. We care for the playground.
6. We play well with others.

If these rules are kept the children are rewarded with house points, class smileys, marbles of good choices (which are saved towards a treat), stickers and certificates. They will also receive a green sticker to bring home on a Friday to let you know that they have stayed in the green light all week. If the rules are broken we operate a daily traffic light system in class and a card system outdoors in the following way:

Initially the children are given a verbal reminder. If they persist their name is moved from the green to amber light and five minutes playtime is missed. If the behaviours continue then their name is moved into the red light and a whole outdoor playtime is missed. In the event of serious behaviours Mrs Bushell is notified and we would discuss these with you.

Hopefully we won't be employing these strategies too much!

We would also like to take this opportunity to thank you for your co-operation in letting the children come in independently in the morning.
