Children should come to school dressed in their PE kit on the days they receive PE lessons.

We would also like to remind you that children should not wear earrings at all in school as if an accident does happen a child could be injured by the jewellery. If you send your child to school with studs, they will need to be able to remove them to do PE safely. They will also need to be able to reinsert them so they do not get misplaced. We would prefer that on a PE day they do not wear them at all.

If your child has just had their ears pierced and can't take them out, then tape can be applied but this must be applied by you or your child and must be removed by you or your child. School staff cannot add/remove tape or remove/insert earrings.
