#### Attendance



Our attendance target this year is 96.5%, which is 0.5% higher than the national average for our age range. So far this term overall attendance is 96.1%, which is fantastic considering all the sickness bugs that the children pass between themselves at this time of year.

Our best attended class each week wins the Attendance cup and the children are always very proud to receive it. So that you can know how your child's attendance measures up against national expectations we will be sending out attendance letters before the end of term. If your child's attendance is above 95% (the national good attendance figure) he/she will receive a certificate of good attendance. Children with attendance above our school target of 96.5% will receive a different certificate to reward their excellent attendance. We know that there are lots of illnesses around, particularly at this time of year, so some children may not receive a certificate this time, but with good attendance they are likely to receive one at the end of the Spring term. Please continue to support your child to have good attendance as this is vital to ensure that he/she reaches his/her full potential.

A big thank you and well done to the Year 3 and 4 children (and their parents) who braved the weather to perform at the Christmas lights switch on last weekend. Despite a couple of challenges the children performed extremely well and their behaviour was fantastic. We were very proud of them all.
