Cragside

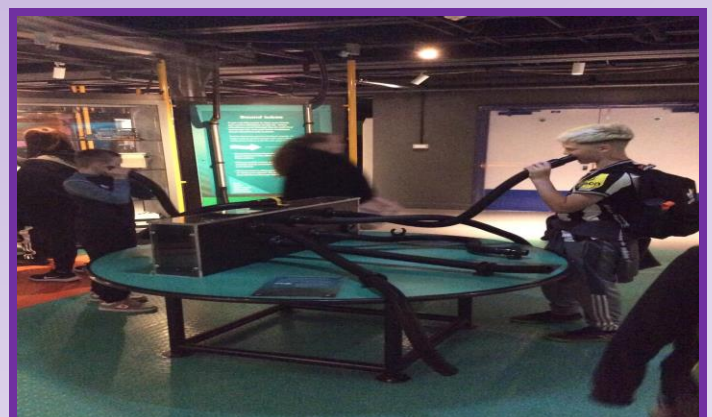
Year 4 had an amazing time at Cragside. They thoroughly enjoyed the outdoors and the weather stayed nice.
