Dear Parents,

This is our plan for the teaching of spelling in Poplar group. Each week we will have a lesson dedicated to these objectives. The children will also complete shorter spelling sessions and work on high frequency words in their own classes. We hope that you find this useful as a guide to help you support your child.

Week number	Spelling Pattern	Reading/Spelling pattern examples
1	Prefix re and sub	redo refresh return review submerge submarine subway
2	Suffix ly and rule for words ending in l	Just add ly - quickly slowly boldly cleverly deeply silently  Double the l to add ly carefully annually wilfully joyfully hopefully beautifully
3	Suffix ly and rule for words ending in le	Change le to ly gently truly terribly simply possibly terribly miserably
4	Suffix ly and rule for words ending in y	Y to i add ly happily angrily cheekily clumsily crazily dreamily
5	Suffix ly and rule for words ending in e	Words ending e add ly politely definitely absolutely completely loosely falsely bravely

### Ongoing:

Homophones. EG, knight/night, their/there/they're, blew/blue.

Words with contractions EG, can't, hasn't, won't, couldn't, didn't, it's, wasn't
