Year 2 Autumn A Maths Plan Mrs Waters' Class

Week	Focus
Week 2	<u>Cross Curricular maths</u> - The children will learn about the days of the week, months of the year and seasons through studying the daily life of Grace Darling. We will revise telling the time to the hour and half hour.
Week 3	Number and place value: The children will learn to recognise the place value of each digit in a 2 digit number. They will read and write numbers to 100 and begin to order numbers to 100. They will explore a number square and say the number before, after and between.
Week 4	Addition: The children will consolidate their knowledge of addition strategies recalling addition facts to 20 with increasing fluency. They will practise using pairs to 10, doubles and place value as strategies. They will use a number line to add crossing a ten including tackling missing numbers.
Week 5	Number and place value: The children will count in steps of 2, 5, 10. They will learn to give 10 more or less and continue sequences in 10s. They will compare numbers and calculations using the < > signs.
Week 6	Subtraction: The children will consolidate their knowledge of subtraction strategies recalling the subtraction facts to 20 with increasing fluency. They will subtract using a range of strategies.
Week 7	Shape: The children will identify and describe the properties of 2-D shapes. They will compare and sort 2-D shapes using a range of criteria.
Week 8	Cross curricular maths related to our theme week where appropriate

The weekly order of the maths topics may vary from the plan outlined above, depending on the learning needs of the children at the time.
