

### Literacy

The children will read various short stories and answer VIPERS questions. They will write predictions and use inference.

This term we will also recap a lot of grammar work and practise how to answer questions in preparation for the SATs in May.

### Computing

The children will learn about programming. They will create a game using Scratch which includes variables and evaluate it as they go.

### Music

The children will listen to recorder playing and learn the first notes to play themselves. They will then play simple tunes. They will compose their own tune and evaluate their performance.

### Design and Technology

The children will investigate healthy eating and design and will make their own healthy recipe. They will learn where food comes from and how to be environmentally aware.

### French

The children will continue to go shopping in France and use their knowledge of numbers to buy certain items and give change.

### RE

The children will explore justice and freedom and look at human rights.

### PSHE

### PE

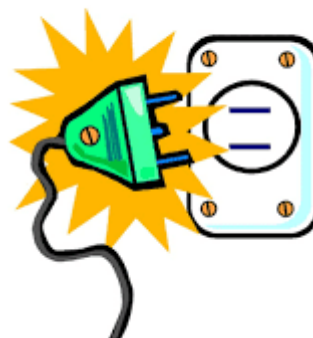
Hockey
