# Nursery will work as a self contained bubble!

All of the children will be able to attend and we will work as a self contained bubble in one half of the Early Years building.

Pre-school will also be back, welcoming 2 year olds in the morning and afternoon. They will work as a self contained bubble in the other half of the building.

At this time the children will not be mixing together. Although we hope this will be a temporary measure.



# washing and cleaning!

The children won't be required to socially distance. However there will be plenty of hand washing and cleaning in place. The shared toys and resources will be cleaned daily and the children and staff will be washing their hands regularly throughout the day. We will also have some adaptations to our provision, such as disposable painting aprons for example.

To minimise contact between children and parents in the school we have staggered the start and end times for different classes of children. Our start time is 9.00am.

Due to the added complications of the building work we cannot use the Nursery gate for the first half term, therefore we will be using Entrance A to avoid cross over with other parents. This is the gate at the top of the ramp in the picture.

cross the

through the side gate

straight ahead

turn left and use the second door

Go straight across the main school yard from the gate Through the black gate at the right of the Nursery building

Go straight ahead, following the right side of the building to the back

Turn left at the very back of the building and go to the second door











There may be occasions, on a lunchtime when Pre-school will be leaving as you come in the side gate. In order to maintain distancing we will be operating a keep right system for entering and exiting. Please look out for any markings on the ground.



## Bringing The children In!

The government guidance advises not allowing parents to come into the building due to the Coronavirus.

However we appreciate that the children are young, new or have had a lengthy period away so we are prepared to waive this initially.

But please could you:-

- Sanitise hands on the way in
- Remain for as short a period as possible
- Adhere to social distancing wherever possible
