Near Miss

We have had a report of a near miss outside the school. A parent reported that a driver of a large four by four was parked up on the kerb on the corner of Ridge Terrace and Cumberland Avenue and pulled off without looking, forcing the parent to have to pull back her child's buggy very quickly to avoid it being hit. Clearly this could have been a very serious accident.



Once again we urge parents to park considerately towards local residents and pedestrians and to be extremely careful when parking or pulling away. It is particularly difficult to notice small children and buggies from a high vehicle and younger children are less aware of dangers than adult drivers.
