In Literacy we will be working on recognising our names

Copying patterns, hearing the sound at the start of our names. As the children are becoming Reception ready they will begin some phonics work.

In Mathematics we will be learning to count, recognise numbers and shapes in addition to making patterns.

We will also be following the interests of the children, which may mean the planning we make available changes at short notice.

Lunch

Lunch needs to be ordered in advance online for the children in Nursery and is only available for those children accessing a full day in Nursery. Please contact Mrs Markham-Lee in the office for details. The information is also available in your admissions pack.

Alternatively your child may bring a packed lunch. Please could you name the box/bag.

Water Bottles

We have provided the children with a water bottle or they may bring their own if you wish. Please could they only bring water in the bottle in line with the school policy.

Learning Journals

We will be building an on-line Learning Journal (via Tapestry) with your child over the course of the year, which will include examples of learning in school, such as photos and short video clips, along with flagging the 7 areas your child is working in during the activity. We hope you will be able to share some of your child's learning at home with us too or comment on their learning so we can get a picture of the child at home and in school. There is the opportunity for you to download this as a PDF file at the end of the Reception year to keep. We may also send messages to you in this way. If you should need any further support to set this up please see a member of staff. Please don't send important messages this way as we could miss them since we don't check Tapestry during the day.

Homework & Remote Learning

In Nursery we don't give the children homework as such, but we may provide practical activities during the holidays, which you may like to do with them. These will be shared via Tapestry.

We may also suggest activities to move your child's learning on within their Tapestry observations.

In the event of a child or the class having to isolate we will provide remote learning, on Tapestry, in the form of practical activities to do with your child and links to appropriate learning websites, such as Hungry Little Minds.
