DINNER MONEY INFORMATION SHEET

The cost of a school lunch is as follows:

1 day	£2.10
2 days	£4.20
3 days	£6.30
4 days	£8.40
5 days	£10.50

- Dinner money must be brought into school on <u>Monday mornings</u>. If your child is absent, dinner money should be brought in on his/her first day of return.
- If we do not receive dinner money payment by <u>Wednesday</u>, we will send a reminder letter home with your child.
- Any money sent into school should be in a sealed envelope, money bag or named purse, with your child's name, class and the total amount enclosed written clearly.
- <u>Please</u> do try to send in the correct amount of money to save time for both the teacher and the school office.
- Method of payment: You may choose to pay by cheque or with cash. Cheques should be made payable to "Northumberland County Council." You may also pay by direct debit, which you can set up through 'Live Kitchen' once you have registered your e-mail address with the school office. Direct Debit payments are taken a month in arrears.
- The minimum you should pay is the total number of dinners for the week. If you prefer, you may pay for any number of weeks in advance. (For example: for the whole half-term).
- If your child is absent, or is sent home ill, you will not be charged for these lunches. Any credit will be carried over to the following week.
- If your child does not like the menu on a particular day, you may swap from school meals to packed lunches, there is no need to inform the school office.
- Free School Meals If you think you qualify for Free School Meals, a form can be collected from the school office and once evidence to support your application has been confirmed, your entitlement will start when written confirmation has been received from Northumberland County Council.
