


Growth Mindset at West End First

We use displays, stories and puppets to teach these initially. We then use the language daily.








Learning what happens in our brain as we learn something new

We look at My Fantastic Elastic Brain and talk about the Neurons and Synapses. The children learn that the Synapses or 'pathways' are built when we learn something new. At first the pathways are not very strong so we may make mistakes. These are our first attempts at learning and we learn from these. As we practise more the pathways get stronger until we can do the activity. We need to put in plenty of effort and persevere at times.






Using the Language of Growth Mindset - I Can't Do This Yet!




The Learning Pit


