


Logging into Readiwriter Spelling

Type Readiwriter spelling into your internet search engine and click on the **Readiwriter sign in** link.



Your child should enter their username and password. This is the same username and password as for their Mathletics account.

They can also see their points score as they complete activities. Each week, the children can earn a certificate if they score 1000 points or more. These will be printed out and given to the children.

As well as accessing Readwriter through the spellodrome sign-in screen, the children can also access spellodrome through their Mathletics home page too.
